

## About SFMR

Doctors and scientists at the University of California, San Francisco are creating a mammography registry to learn more about breast imaging tests

, and breast health. The main goals of the registry are to better understand how well breast imaging tests find breast cancer

All women having breast imaging tests (mammograms, breast ultrasound, breast magnetic resonance imaging) at participating radiology practices in the San Francisco Bay Area <sup>[1]</sup>

are asked to participate. Women are asked to complete a one page Breast Health History Questionnaire. Radiology information from breast imaging tests find breast cancer.

SFMR scientists belong to the National Cancer Institute Breast Cancer Surveillance Consortium, which pools information from mammography registries across the United States <sup>[2]</sup>

for analysis and publication in scientific journals. All information combined by SFMR and consortium scientists for publication
